## Drinking Age of 21 Works

Researchers analyzed studies conducted since 2006 and found that a minimum drinking age of 21 is associated with a reduced rate of drunk driving crashes among American youth. That age limit also lowers young people's risk of other health threats associated with heavy drinking such as dating violence, unsafe sex, and suicide.

A 2011 study found that 36 percent of U.S. college students said they'd gone binge drinking (five or more drinks in one sitting) within the past two weeks. That was 7 percent lower than in 1988, the first year that all states had a legal drinking age of 21.

Studies have shown that student drinking declines when college towns boost enforcement of the law and warn students about the crackdown.

## Zohydro is Coming to a Pharmacy Near You

Within the next month it's likely a long-acting, hydrocodone-based narcotic, 5 to 10 times more powerful than OxyContin, will be available for sale. Health care and addiction treatment groups, state attorney generals, and members of congress are urging the FDA to revoke its approval of the drug Zohydro citing the parallel increase in opioid prescribing and overdose deaths over the past 15 years. Prescription drug abuse continues to be one of the nation's most concerning drug problems and one that the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Prevention classifies as "an epidemic."
